Title of the lecture:

How does ankle joint locking affect plantar forefoot pressure in people with diabetes?



Brief introduction about the presentation:

The study investigated opportunities to improve the treatment of foot ulcers in people with diabetes from a prosthetic and orthotic perspective. This was done by evaluating the efficacy of ankle-foot orthosis (AFO) that allows mobility in the ankle joint, compared to the traditional knee-high aids used in wound care that lock the ankle, e.g. AFO with locked ankle joint.
